### Feeding on Foolishness

***“The heart of him who has understanding seeks knowledge, but the mouth of fools feeds on foolishness.”*** Proverbs 15:14 NKJV

The Bible focuses attention on our motives. Not just, the things we do, but why we do them. Our actions can help demonstrate our priorities and what is important to us. Yet these actions cannot reveal what is in our hearts.

The Bible tells us that some people have “understanding.” These people are not dominated by their personal desires (or the images they want to create).

Instead, they are humble, and have hearts eager to learn more from God. They desire to develop more of the resources they have been given and grow in their faith. They demonstrate this commitment by craving “knowledge” and having hearts yearning for a deeper walk with God.

In contrast, some people are “fools.” The Hebrew word suggests that, from God’s perspective, they are dominated by silly and fruitless pursuits. They trust in flawed human beings, and reject His wisdom. As a companion verse says, ***“The wisdom of the sensible is to understand his way, but the foolishness of fools is deceit”*** (v. 8).
